*All entries POSTMARKED AFTER February 24, 2017 will be considered "Day of Show" entries at the rate of \$18 per run with no discounts.*

Double Run Format & Walk Once & Run Same Course 2 times!

**Please review your confirmations carefully!**

**NO Changes will be made to your entry at the show!!!**

**Notice to Exhibitors: Trial will follow NADAC rules and regulations.** Copies of the NADAC Exhibitors handbook are available at [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com).

→ All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in NADAC Agility Trials. Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry. Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the Agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in control will be excused from the Agility trial. Any owner, handler, or spectator exhibiting poor sportsmanship or abuse towards a dog or person will be required to leave the show site for the duration of the trial.

→ No refunds will be made for entries withdrawn after the closing date. In the event that the trial cannot be held for reasons beyond the show committee's control, no refunds will be made.

→ No leads or collars shall be permitted on the course at any time. **Per NADAC rules: food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a ziploc bag or small container such as a pill bottle. The container cannot be visible in the ring nor within 10 feet of the ring. You cannot indicate to your dog that you have this item on you i.e. patting your pocket. You are not allowed to remove the container until you are at least 10 feet outside the ring. ALL FOOD AND TOYS MUST BE CONTAINED AT THE TRIAL AND NONE CAN BE LEFT LYING ABOUT LOOSE**

→ All dogs must be on leash or securely crated when not in the ring.

→ Austin K9Xpress Agility Club may refuse any entry on the basis expressly provided through the NADAC rules and regulations. Anyone not currently in good standing NADAC or K9Xpress will not be allowed to enter the trial (this includes those with outstanding returned checks).

→ Entries must be made on the enclosed entry forms. Copies may be made. **No other forms will be accepted.** Entries must be signed and be accompanied by the correct entry fees to be valid. Entry forms must be completely filled out and legible.

→ Dog sales or puppies under eight weeks old are not permitted on the trial site.

→ No catalogs will be printed. Running order lists will be printed and posted at the ring gate. Handlers with multiple dogs will be separated as much as the class allows.

→ Austin K9Xpress Agility Training Club, its board of directors, NADAC, management and the property owner assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, or children.

→ Dripping Springs Ranch Park and/or Austin K9Xpress will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at the event is in the care, custody & control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

→ Final run order will be included in e-mailed confirmations the week before the trial.

→ Doors open for set up at 2:00PM on Friday. Check in begins at 2:30 PM. Friday night briefing will begin at 3:00 PM, with first dog on the line at 3:15 PM.

Check-in Saturday and Sunday will be from 7:00 to 7:30 am, with the first dog on the line at 8:00 am. You only need to check in on the first day that you are entered.

→ Dogs requiring Measurement: Proficient, Elite, Open, Novice - Jumping 4", 8", 12", or 16", which do not have a permanent height card. *Bring your height card with you, even if you mail a copy of it with your entries. Dogs who do NOT need to be measured: VH/JH Dogs jumping 16" or lower Dogs jumping 20", Skilled, Intro or those with permanent height card or dogs on the height exemption list.*

**→ There will be move-ups for Saturday to Sunday only. Move-ups must be turned in no later than 15 minutes after the last scores are posted on Saturday.**

→ **Food:** There are several fast food and dine-in restaurants within 10 minutes of the trial site. We may have lunch available. Details will be in your confirmation the week before the trial.

→ **Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> places in all jump heights in all classes. Rosettes will be awarded for those finishing a title, and Qualifying Rosettes will be awarded for those achieving a qualifying score. There are no placement ribbons awarded in Chances as it is a pass/fail class.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com) for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.

Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.

The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

#### NON-JUMPING CLASSES – VETERAN OR DISABLED HANDLER

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

#### IMPORTANT.

Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the [www.NADACForum.com](http://www.NADACForum.com) within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to [www.NADACForum.com](http://www.NADACForum.com) and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records. The Proficient category now allows for 5 point Q's.

#### Entry Fees:

1-8 runs = \$14.00 per run

9-15 runs = \$12.00 per run

16-19 runs = \$11.00 per run

20 or more runs = \$10.00 per run

#### Number of runs based on dog living in the same house

Junior handler entry per run = \$7.00

Day of show Junior Handler per run = \$10.00

**Veteran or Disabled Handler (for non-traditional classes) Please enclose proof of age or handicap. We do NOT keep this on file from prior shows.**

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1. As used here "NADAC" means North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
2. Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
5. Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees, and members) and Austin K9Xpress Agility Training Club, (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), and Dripping Springs Ranch Park, (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
6. Exhibitor understands there is a returned check fee of \$25.

In consideration of the acceptance of the entry, I/we agree to abide by the rules and Regulations of NADAC in effect at the time of this trial, and by any additional rules and regulations as approved by the board of NADAC for this trial. I/We certify that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or to other dogs. I/We further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed above.
